Hosting Period: 4 weeks (Mid July-Mid August)

Japanese Youth Characteristics:

- 12-16 years old (most are 12-14) or adult chaperones
- Youth have limited English language skills, and host families should be prepared to communicate imaginatively

Host Family Requirements:

- You must have a child of the same gender and within 3 years of the hosted youth (families without children of the appropriate age may host an adult chaperone)
- No special activities need to be planned, these youth want to experience American culture, make new friends, and improve their English by staying with your family!
- Volunteer to participate in the program
- You don't need to be involved with 4-H to host
