

2021 State Competition Volunteer Reminders

Thank you for volunteering your time to help make our 2021 Shooting Sports State Competition a success! Below you will find a few reminders for the day to help make your experience as smooth as possible.

- **ALL volunteers must wear a mask at all times**
 - If you need to remove your mask for any reason make sure you are at least 6ft from those around you and replace it as soon as possible.
- Make sure you know your designated range, assignment, and shift time before arriving at the event.
- Read your assignment SOP so you are familiar with your job responsibilities before arriving.
- Plan to arrive for your shift 10-15 minutes early so that there are no delays on the range.
- **Where should I report for my shift on Friday?**
 - All Friday set-up volunteers should report to the Bluegrass Sportsmen's League clubhouse and check-in with Ashley Marcum, State Specialist.
- **Where should I report for my shift on Saturday?**
 - 1st shift Registration/Volunteer Coordinators – report to the Clubhouse **BEFORE 6:45am EST** and check-in with Ashley Marcum. You will pick up your range notebook and supplies at this time.
 - Target Calculation/Computer Input/Award Ceremony Volunteers – report to the Clubhouse and check-in with Ashley Marcum
 - All other volunteers – report to your designated range/area and check-in with your range Volunteer Coordinator.
- **Where should I report for my shift on Sunday?**
 - 1st shift volunteers – report to the clubhouse **at 7:30am EST** and check-in with Ashley Marcum.
 - 2nd shift volunteers – report to your assigned range to check-in
 - Award Ceremony Volunteers – report to the Clubhouse and check-in with Ashley Marcum.
- Remember, safety is our number one priority. If you notice something unsafe report it to your assigned Range Safety Office immediately.
