

KY 4-H Shooting Sports 2022 State Competition Reminders

Please Distribute to Parents, Coaches and Participants

Covid-19 Guidelines:

- Any COVID-19 guidelines in place at the time of competition will be strictly adhered to. This information will be provided to all participants prior to the event.

General Information For Both Days:

- One person from your county should check-in and pick up your County Packet in the clubhouse
 - **Must check in by 9am EST/8am CST**
- All competitors are required to wear a name badge (template can be found online) during the competition in a visible area to Range Officers. Name badges must include:
 - Competitors Name
 - County
 - Guardian Signature
 - Agent Signature
 - Recent Photo
- If there is a concern regarding a participants score, or other grievance, it must be brought to the attention of the Range Officer immediately.
 - Once a participant leaves the range, scores are considered final
 - If needed the Range Officer will bring the grievance to the attention of the Rules Committee to review
- Targets/Scorecards are not given back to participants or their counties, they are retained as written record of the event.
- CHECKING FOR SCORES: all scores will be posted at the Clubhouse and online.
- No unauthorized individuals will be allowed in the Clubhouse either day.
- No coaches or parents are allowed on the firing line.
- Eye and ear protection are required on all ranges except Archery.
- **NO CHANGES** are permitted the day of the event.
- Port-a-Johns will be provided both days.
- Concessions and merchandise will be available both days
 - On Saturday, both the concession stands and merchandise sales will be at the General Purpose Range near the Rifle and Pistol Ranges.
 - On Sunday, concession and merchandise sales will be in front of the Clubhouse.
- For counties bringing their own concession, please refrain from operating a generator or grill close to a range, as it can be a source of distraction and a safety hazard.
 - **MUST** follow all Covid-19 guidelines for food handling!
- **NO** drones are allowed at this event.



- In the event of lightening all shooting activities will be suspended until 30 minutes after the last sighting of lightning. All participants and spectators should return to their vehicles until activities resume.
- An EMT will be onsite both days.

Saturday Information:

- Each county must fill out one (1) Bluegrass Sportsmen's League Guest Pass (found online) for the entire county listing all 4-H participants and turn it in at County Packet Pick-up.
- All paper targets will be at each range when competitor's check-in; targets are not available at the clubhouse.
- Some disciplines require labels for participant's targets, these can be created beforehand (template available online) or youth can legibly write all information on the back of their target the day of the event. Disciplines requiring labels include:
 - Air Rifle/BB – 3 targets
 - .22 Sport & Target Rifle – 3 targets
 - Air & .22 Pistol – 4 targets
 - Black Powder Flintlock, Percussion & Pistol – 1 target
 - Archery cards are provided and filled out before the event
- Labels should include:
 - Competitors Name
 - County
 - Registration #
 - Age Group (9-11, 12-14, 15-18)
 - Discipline (be specific, i.e. .22 Sport Rifle)
 - Position (if applicable)
- Any youth participating in .22 Pistol or Black Powder Pistol must complete a Federal Handgun Consent Form (available online) and have it on their person, NOT in gun case, at all times during the event as they may be asked by an official to show it.
- Check-in at all ranges will begin at 7:30am EST/6:30am CST **EXCEPT** for .22 Target Rifle which will begin at 7am EST/6am CST.
 - Any youth participating in .22 Target Rifle must be checked in **no later than 7:30am EST/6:30am CST**
 - Only two (2) Target Rifle relays will be held so it is imperative the 4-Her is on time, these will be the first 2 squads to compete
 - **All participants must be checked in at all other ranges no later than 12:00pm (noon) EST/11:00am CST**
 - If a youth is not checked in by this time they will not be able to compete in that discipline



- All ranges (except .22 Target Rifle) will place their first squad on the line at 8am EST/7am CST
- For location of ranges please see the aerial map online. Maps will also be available in the Clubhouse
- The road to all ranges at BGSJ is ONE WAY – to the right at the fork with a speed limit of 20 MPH. This will be monitored and enforced by KY National Guard and Wilmore Police.
- There is a designated County Meeting Area (see BGSJ map online). Counties should use this area as the main meeting space to prepare their 4-Her's for their events, prepare snacks, ect. This is the preferred site for grilling.
- If anyone from your county requires wheelchair access or assistance to ranges please have them come to the clubhouse before traveling to the ranges.
- An Awards Ceremony will be held immediately following the end of all events under the covered patio at the Clubhouse.

Sunday Information:

- All ranges will put their first squad on the line at 8am EST/7am CST.
- Participants must report to their assigned range prior to the call for their squad. Competitors not reporting on time will be disqualified.
- An Awards Ceremony will immediately follow the Trap events.
