



KY 4-H Shooting Sports 2022 State Competition Information

This event, held annually in September, is the culminating event for youth enrolled in a county 4-H Shooting Sports program. This event is designed to develop independence, promote safe and responsible shooting practices, and provide a goal to work towards for youth involved within the program. Each day of competition ends with an awards ceremony recognizing both individuals and teams.

Registration:

- **County Roster Deadline** – June 30th, 2022 @ midnight
 - Each county 4-H Shooting Sports Program must submit roster information through 4-H Online. Roster information must be submitted by County Agent, only youth listed on these rosters will be permitted to compete in the State Competition
- **State Online Registration Deadline** – August 2nd, 2022 @ 6pm EST/5pm CST (**check with your agent for county deadline**)
 - Online registration must be completed by Extension Staff
 - Youth can be registered for **three (3)** events on Saturday and **one (1)** event on Sunday
- **Volunteer Sign-up Deadline** – August 2nd, 2022 @ 6pm EST/5pm CST
 - All volunteers must be registered via the Qualtrics link provided to agents by this deadline, if not received your county will be excluded from this year's competition, additional information about volunteer requirements can be found below
- **Registration Review Deadline** – August 19th, 2022 @ 6pm EST/5pm CST
 - Counties have until this deadline to review their submitted registration and make substitutions, changes, and additions, after this deadline no changes can be made
 - No registrations will be taken the day of the event
- A county verification form along with all registration fees are due to the State Office (Attn: Ashley Marcum) by Sept. 2nd
 - Late fees will apply after this date
 - No refunds will be given after Sept. 2nd
 - Make all checks payable to the KY 4-H Foundation





Covid-19 Guidelines:

- Any COVID-19 guidelines in place at the time of competition will be strictly adhered to. This information will be provided to all participants prior to the event.

Important Details:

- Before attending or competing in the State Competition please become familiar with the Kentucky 4-H State Shooting Sports Education Rules that can be found on the 4-H Shooting Sports website. These rules will be followed and enforced at all times. Not having previous knowledge of a rule does not excuse breaking one.
- Disciplines offered at the State Competition include:
 - Archery Bowhunter
 - Archery Target Compound
 - Archery Target Recurve
 - Archery Bare Compound
 - Archery Bare Recurve
 - Black Powder Flintlock
 - Black Powder Percussion
 - Black Powder Pistol**
 - .22 Target Rifle
 - .22 Sport Rifle
 - .22 Pistol**
 - Air Rifle Target
 - Air Rifle Sport
 - Air Pistol
 - BB Gun
 - Trap (Division 1 & Division 2)

All disciplines are divided into three age categories, 9-11, 12-14, and 15-18 EXCEPT for those marked with **. These disciplines are only for youth in the 12-14 and 15-18 age groups. Teams in each age category, within each discipline, consist of the top four (4) scorers EXCEPT for Black Powder Pistol, Black Powder Flintlock and Trap. These teams consist of the top three (3) scorers in Black Powder and top five (5) scorers in Trap.

- All disciplines listed above are offered on Saturday EXCEPT for Trap (division 1 & Division 2) which is offered on Sunday.
- Youth may be registered for three (3) events on Saturday and one (1) event on Sunday.

Volunteer Information:

- Per the Kentucky State 4-H Shooting Sports Education Program Rules every county is required to provide 1 volunteer for every 4 participants (or portion thereof) at both the Saturday and Sunday event.
- Each county participating in the State Competition is required to register their volunteers via the Qualtrics link provided to agents by August 2nd @ 6pm EST/5pm CST with enough volunteers to fulfill the requirement above.
 - If a county does not meet this deadline they will be excluded from that year's competition
- There will be limited spots available for volunteers to assist with range set-up at Bluegrass Sportsman's League from 9am to 5pm EST the Friday before competition begins, if your county sends a volunteer to assist with this it will count as one (1) volunteer slot filled for both the Saturday and Sunday event.
- Coaches, parents, or other county volunteers can fill these volunteer positions.
- Once volunteers have been registered individuals will be assigned to a range or other needed position, this assignment will be communicated to each volunteer prior to the event.
