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Welcome to the Kentucky 4H virtual experience. Today we were focusing on 4H cloverbuds. My name is Jennifer Tackett and I'm an extension specialist for 4H Youth development

Today we're going to do a natural resource activity called natural images. You'll need construction paper, liquid tempera paint, a pump spray bottle (a window cleaner bottle works) leaves, sticks, flowers feathers or other small natural items.

Go outside and collect some natural items, You may have to use books to flatten them for use for our project. Then arrange the items on paper anyway you wish. Next, add your paint to the spray bottle. Finally spray the paper with the paint. Remove your natural items from the paper and show how they have left their image. You can look outside for natural images around your home or school. See if you can find out lines of leaves left on the sidewalk after a rainstorm.
