Welcome to the Kentucky 4H virtual experience today we're going to focus on 4H cloverbuds. My name is Jennifer Tackett and I am an extension specialist for 4H youth development

Today we're going to focus on expressive arts and make a kazoo. The materials you will need is an empty toilet paper roll, rubber bands, wax paper, markers and some stickers to decorate.

Let's first start by practicing how to hum. A kazoo is an instrument that helps make a humming sound louder by making more vibrations.

You will start by poking a hole about the size of a pencil one inch from the bottom of one end of the toilet paper tube. Place the wax paper over one end of the tube hold the wax paper in place by putting the rubber band around the tube. Next you can hum in the opened of the kazoo. Choose a tune that everybody knows maybe the ABCs or happy birthday. Invite some friends over and start your own kazoo band.
