Today we're going to be doing a communications and expressive arts activity called mixed media. All you need is more than one piece of medium (paint, glue, paper, pencils, markers, etc). Today I am making a mixed media project using an old 45 record, paint, coloring pages, glue, and a paint marker.

Gather your supplies. I am cutting my cardstock coloring paper to fit my 45 record. Next, I am gluing the paper to the center. Now am I going to paint the paper. After the paint dries you can modge podge over it. I then used a paint marker to write on the record.

You don't have to use a record, use different mediums on paper, canvas, or wood. Be creative and have fun.
