

Volunteer Kentucky! Culminating Project

Each participant shall design an individual volunteer project as a culminating project for Volunteer Kentucky! The individual volunteer project will place the participant in the role as Volunteer Administrator, will fill a need in the individual's organization and will involve each category in the GEMS Model of Volunteer Administration.

Each individual volunteer project shall include the following components:

- Description of the Organization and Volunteer Program
A description of the participant's organization and the volunteer program in which the participant serves as a volunteer administrator. Include specific information about the organization, the programs it delivers and the audience(s) it serves.
- Identification of the Need for the Project
Explain why this project is needed. How does it contribute to the mission of the organization? How does it serve the needs of the clientele? How does it enhance the role of the volunteer administrator?
- Overview of the Project
A description of the Project, including the target audience and intended outcomes.
- Explain how each of the categories of the GEMS Model were addressed in the project
 - Generate
 - Educate
 - Mobilize
 - Sustain
- Report Results and Impacts
Provide measurable results and quantifiable impacts of the individual project. (Note: the number of volunteers, the number of volunteer hours and the average hourly value of volunteer time are inputs rather than measurable impacts.)
