## USE AGREEMENT OF 4-H CAMPS—FOOTBALL CAMP

- A. A team representative must submit the High School Football Camp Application with a \$100 non-refundable deposit. The application and deposit should be mailed to 17575 Hwy 196 Nancy, KY 42544. Please make the check payable to UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY with Football Camp on the memo line. Both the application and the deposit check must be received to confirm rental dates.
- B. Football camp costs \$40 per person per night. This cost includes 3 meals. Facilities may be shared between multiple schools/teams.
- C. The team representative and the onsite coaching staff will be held responsible for conduct and action of team members while they are on site. Charges will be assessed for any and all damages to the facilities and grounds, including but not limited to defacing of property, broken furniture, graffiti, and broken windows. Groups are expected to leave the grounds clean.
- D. At least one adult team leader must be present prior to the arrival of team members to check in the Camp Director or Camp Staff. Leaders are expected to orient team members to the camp facilities and rules.
- E. Meals must be prepared by camp staff. No outside providers, including booster clubs, are allowed. Final participant numbers (players, adult leaders and coaches) must be submitted 10 days prior to arrival. Food will be ordered based on the submitted numbers. Please let us know any special dietary needs or requests at this time. Menus are available for review in early May and include larger meat portions for players and staff. Late cancellations may be billed for unused food.
- F. Participants bring their own towels, linen, and bedding. There is a minimum of 15 persons per cabin.
- G. We start making extra ice prior teams arrivals, but if the weather is hot and demand is high we may run low. Teams should be prepared to buy ice at the nearest store at their own expense.

## FOOTBALL CAMP RULES

- A. NO SWIMMING IN THE LAKE WITHOUT A LIFEJACKET and lifeguard
- B. No alcoholic beverages, no drugs, no explosives and/or firearms are allowed on camp premises. 4-H camp facilities are operated under the direction of the University of Kentucky, College of Agriculture's Cooperative Extension Service and 4-H Programs and are subject to their rules and regulations.
- C. Parking is permitted in designated areas only. Camp Staff will direct you.
- D. No tobacco products are allowed in any building or wooded area of the camps. Smoking and other tobacco products use is permitted only in designated area behind the country store.
- E. Fishing requires a lifejacket and a current Kentucky fishing license for those over 16.
- F. Swimming or canoeing activities require a lifeguard to be on duty (**absolutely no exceptions**). The camp may assist in securing a lifeguard. You may provide your own properly certified lifeguard. A current lifeguard certificate is required. A copy of the certification must be presented for our records. A life jacket **MUST** be worn, at all times for any lakefront activities.
- G. In addition to the lifeguard certification, for youth groups a canoe lifeguard must show proof of waterfront rescue training. A copy of the certification card must be presented for our records.
- H. Pets are not permitted on camp property.
- I. Transportation in vehicles where seats are not attached is NOT permitted. This includes (but is not limited to) wagons, car trunks, and backs of pick-up trucks.
- J. Use of motorized vehicles such as ATV's and golf carts is permitted for transporting equipment and/or supplies **ONLY**. They must remain parked and locked at all other times. They are permitted only on camp roadways or access trails. Teams who choose to bring ATV's or golf carts must notify Camp Director in advance.
- K. RV's and Pop-up tents are NOT allowed on camp property.
