Expectations:

NRESci Retreat Event

- Attend the NRESci Retreat.
- Prepare and present a presentation to NRESci scholars at retreat.
- Plan for program year activities and events.
- Assist instructors at the retreat as needed.

NRESci Ambassador Board Meetings and Retreat

- Attend the Board Meetings and Retreat.
- Plan and prepare for 4-H Summit and Teen Conference responsibilities.

4-H Summit Event

- Attend 4-H Summit.
- Present an educational session at 4-H Summit.
- Assist NRESci Teaching Team as needed.

4-H Teen Conference Event

- Attend 4-H Teen Conference.
- Assist natural resource instructors as needed during major sessions.

Community Service Project

- Plan and implement a community service project related to natural resources and environmental sciences. A 2-page project report must be completed and turned in to the NRESci Teaching Team by the Summer Event.

You must do at least one of the options below and submit the Ambassador Teen Board Event Form after completing the task or event.

- Attend one regional NRESci event.
- Participate in an Envirothon Team.
- Start an Envirothon Team.
- Present at the KY Association for Environmental Education Conference or other professional conference setting on the NRESci Program.
- Assist at 4-H Natural Resources Day at the Kentucky State Fair.
