

## 4-H Bird Feeder Kit

*Kentucky State Fair: Woodworking Class 674:* Level 1, made from a kit. Simple items which have pre-cut and pre-drilled parts and youth demonstrate knowledge of assembly, selection and use of fasteners (nails, screws and/or glue), sanding techniques, and appropriate finishes. (Examples could include but not limited to: small bird house, non-hopper bird feeder, etc.) Item must demonstrate skill with fasteners, sanding and appropriate finish (no puzzles).

### Kit Includes:

2:A – Bottom pieces (3/4" x 5 1/2" x 11")

2:B – Side pieces (3/4" x 1 1/2" x 11")

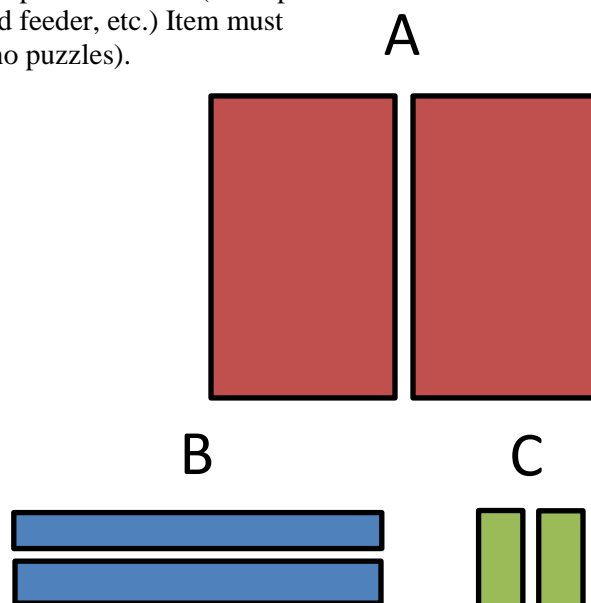
2:C – Side pieces (3/4" x 1 1/2" x 9 1/2")

2 – 2' (1/4") rope

1 – 5' (1/4") rope

12 – 1 1/4" screws

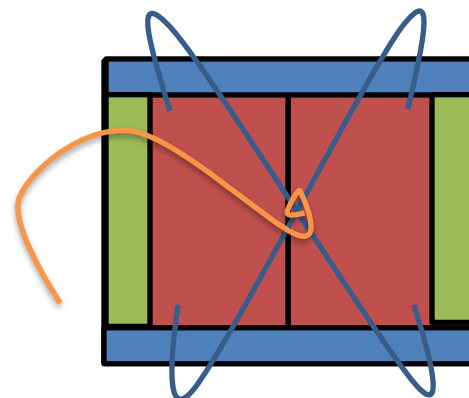
1qt – Bird Seed



1. Place 2(A) boards side by side
2. Screw 2(B) boards on across each end, 2 screws per board in pre-drilled holes
3. Screw 2(C) boards on each side to complete the square, 2 screws per board in pre-drilled holes
4. Screw side pieces together through pre-drilled holes
5. Criss-cross each 2' rope section, run through drilled holes, tie small knot to hold. (Ropes should form an X when complete)
6. Tie 5' rope to cross section to hang
