



4-H Shooting Sports Camp Information

Youth will have the opportunity to learn about and shoot in all shooting sports disciplines including, rifle, shotgun, archery, pistol, black powder and hunter challenge. Campers will learn responsible and safe firearm handling from certified adult and teen instructors. Additional program highlights for the week include campfires, survival skills, nature crafts, heritage foods, and more!

When: April 8-11, 2020

Where: Lake Cumberland 4-H Camp, Jabez, KY

Cost: \$140 per youth and chaperone

Important Details:

- Camp is open to all youth 9-13 years of age as of their 4-H age
- 1 adult chaperone is required for every 5 youth, or portion thereof
 - Must be approved through their county Youth Protection Program
 - Must stay on the campgrounds for the duration of camp, sleep in the cabins and attend class rotation with their campers
- Transportation is the responsibility of the county and or youth attending

Registration:

- Deadline for online registration: March 11 @ 6pm
- All camp attendees (youth, adult chaperones, adult coaches, teen coaches) must complete a paper registration form and medical form to be kept on file during camp
 - All youth must complete a Code of Conduct form
- Online registration must be completed by Extension Staff
- Paperwork and fees are due in to the State Office (Attn: Ashley Marcum) by March 25th
 - Late fees will apply and no refunds will be given after this date
 - Make all checks payable to KY 4-H Foundation
- Teen Coaches must be approved by the selection committee before they are invited to attend camp, DO NOT submit registration for a teen coach before you have received confirmation of their selection, there is no fee for teen coaches selected to attend

- Warm Casual Clothes
- Ear and Eye Protection
- DO NOT bring any guns, archery equipment or ammunition – they will be provided
