GENERAL PURPOSE:

Assist 4-H Agent and/or other 4-H Support Leaders for Teen Conference in chaperoning 4-H'ers to University of Kentucky for 4-H Teen Conference. 4-H Support Leader for Teen Conference will go through orientation and then may be required to help facilitate orientation for Teen Conference Delegates.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE BUT NOT NECESSARILY BE LIMITED TO:

- + Providing transportation to 4-H activities and events related to 4-H Teen Conference
- + Assist with fundraising prior to conference, if needed.
- + Serving as chaperones to all 4-H Teen Conference related events
- + Assisting or leading a Track or Workshop while at 4-H Teen Conference

QUALIFICATIONS:

- + Must complete the Volunteer Application process and be approved by the Youth Protection/Risk Management Committee
- + A sincere interest in sharing knowledge and experiences and skills with youth and adults in an informal educational setting
- + The ability to work and communicate effectively with both youth and adults

+ A willingness to become familiar with and work with the philosophy and guidelines of the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service, Kentucky 4-H program and county 4-H program
