GENERAL PURPOSE:

Assist 4-H Agent and/or other 4-H Support Leaders for Teen Summit in chaperoning 4-H'ers to the Lake Cumberland 4-H Educational Center in Jabez, Kentucky. 4-H Support Leader for Teen Summit will go through orientation and then may be required to help facilitate orientation for 4-H Teen Summit Delegates.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE BUT NOT NECESSARILY BE LIMITED TO:

- + Providing transportation to 4-H activities and events related to 4-H Teen Summit
- + Assist with fundraising prior to event, if needed.
- + Serving as chaperones to all 4-H Teen Summit related events
- + Assisting or leading a workshop or funshop while at 4-H Teen Summit

QUALIFICATIONS:

- + Must complete the Volunteer Application process and be approved by the Youth Protection/Risk Management Committee
- + A sincere interest in sharing knowledge and experiences and skills with youth and adults in an informal educational setting
- + The ability to work and communicate effectively with both youth and adults

+ A willingness to become familiar with and work with the philosophy and guidelines of the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service, Kentucky 4-H program and county 4-H program
